For the third issue of our newsletter, we did a brief interview of the site manager, Raj, from Konform Limited, our groundworks and frame subcontractor, asking about their daily activities and procedures.

What are your working hours?

We turn up to work at 7:30 am and work until 5:00 pm and work some Saturdays as well.

What are your basic health and safety provisions on site?

We have various responsible persons on site including me, the site manager, and site supervisors who are present daily. Along with that our in-house Health & Safety advisor conducts site visits weekly for checks. In addition to the weekly checks, we have daily induction and briefings for the workforce. We also give toolbox talks once a week and regularly check up on our PPE. We have around 25-30 people on site on average and we consider health and safety an important aspect whenever someone joins on site.

What materials and plant do you have on site?

We have various excavators, scissor lifts, pumps for dewatering, small pumps and a tower crane from Trident Lifting Solutions for day to day activities.

When is the tower crane used, is it used throughout the day?

The tower crane runs for approximately 10 hours a day.

How do you encourage diversity in your teams (background)?

We are a diverse team with people from Sri Lanka, India, Albania, Romania, Ireland and the UK.

Do you have any student or graduates in your team?

We have one assistant site engineer who is a recent graduate.

How would you describe working with CMT compared to other general contractors?

So far so good! Except for the slow release of information from the design team, we have no issues from CMT.
